What should I bring with me?

- ◆ Social Security numbers for you, your spouse and all your dependents
 - ◆ Last year's tax returns
 - ◆ W-2s
 - ◆ 1099s
 - ◆ Alimony you have received
 - ◆ Unemployment income statements
 - ◆ Social Security statements
 - ◆ Any other income statements
 - ◆ Tuition payments and student loan interest payments
 - ◆ IRA contributions
 - ◆ Receipt or listing of itemized expenses
 - ◆ Out-of-pocket medical expenses
 - ◆ Non-Cash donations
 - ◆ Cash donations
 - ◆ Vehicle license tabs
 - ◆ Property taxes paid
 - ◆ Mortgage interest paid
 - ◆ Uniform costs
 - ◆ Daycare expenses– name, address and Social Security number or EIN for each provider you paid
 - ◆ Receipts for the Minnesota K-12 Education credit
 - ◆ Property Tax Refund documents
 - ◆ Certificate of Rent Paid from your landlord
 - ◆ Property tax statement
